

Personal Information Collection and Usage Agreement

National Center of the Rights of the Child(NCRC) provides additional family search services to adoptees who do not have identifying birth parent’s information. To provide additional services such as media search(YTN interview, publishing news article, etc.), NCRC must receive consent from the adoptee on collection, use, provision of his/her personal information to third parties. This consent is required by NCRC in accordance with the Personal Information Protection Act. Details about the additional services and consent are described below.

Purpose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▸ Registration of the adoptee’s information on NCRC family search database ▸ Initiation of family search (promotion and management) ▸ Identification of the adoptee (verification) ▸ Production of promotional materials and media publication ▸ Conducting survey or study to develop further post adoption services ▸ Compliance with statutory obligations (Personal Information Protection Act), etc. 		
Information to be Collected	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▸ Basic Information: Information for personal identification <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Photograph, name, date of birth (age), nationality, adoptive country, country of residence, current address, Email address ▸ Additional information: Any relevant information other than basic information <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Phone number, disability, current name, job, health condition 		
Retention Period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▸ Personal information will be collected and retained starting from the date of consent to the completion of family search (family search is complete when the adoptee obtains information about his/her family) ▸ The adoptee may choose to end the retention period, thereby discontinuing family search. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adoptees’ pictures will be publicized for family search. The picture will stop being publicized when: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · the adoptee’s family search is completed · the adoptee intends to discontinue family search

Right to refuse the consent and disadvantages in case of refusal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▸ Consent to collection, use, and provision of “basic information” to third parties is required for family search (news stations/publications and for publicizing the the adoptee’s picture). ▸ The adoptee may refuse to give consent to collection, use, and provision of “additional information” to third parties. However, if the adoptee doing so, his/her family search may not be promoted.
